The annual meeting of the research programme of the École française d'Athènes "Interactions, juxtapositions, religious imbrications in Greece and the Balkans (20th-21st centuries)" will explore interdisciplinarity and methodological approaches to shared sacred spaces.

Following on from the previous meeting on 22 and 23 March 2022, this event will allow the members of this network and scholars from the local community in Rome to deepen methodological conversations concerning of their respective work. The three sessions present findings from ethnographies carried out this year followed by open discussion through round tables.

This workshop will also be a great opportunity to bring together the teams of two groups of researchers working on the same issues: *ShaRP Lab* (Sharing Religious Places), which is an international network of scholars interested in inter-religious interaction, devoting special attention to its spatial dynamics; and *Shared Sacred Sites*, another collaborative network of scholars using multiple tools such as GIS mapping, storytelling, exhibitions, etc. Both of these three groups are involved in Digital Humanities projects that will be presented in the third session.
